January 16 is Deadline to Apply For SBA Economic Injury Disaster Loans

ATLANTA - The U.S. Small Business Administration is reminding businesses in Louisiana that Economic Injury Disaster Loans are still available to small businesses economically impacted by the severe storms and tornadoes that occurred April 4, 2008.

“Businesses that suffered economic losses as a result of the disaster and want to apply for low-interest loans from the SBA are urged to do so before the **January 16** deadline,” said Frank Skaggs, Director of SBA Field Operations Center East.

Small businesses in the following parishes are eligible to apply: East Carroll, Madison and Tensas in the State of Louisiana.

“These parishes are eligible because they are contiguous to one or more primary counties in the State of Mississippi. The Small Business Administration recognizes that disasters do not usually stop at county or state lines. For that reason, counties adjacent to primary counties named in the declaration are included,” said Skaggs.

Loans are available up to \$1.5 million for small businesses that suffered substantial economic injury from the disaster. These working capital loans may be used to pay fixed debts, payroll, accounts payable, and other bills that could have been paid had the disaster not occurred. These loans are not intended to replace lost sales or profits.

The interest rate on these loans is 4 percent, with a maximum term of 30 years. The SBA determines the amount of economic injury and the terms of each loan based on the financial circumstances of each borrower. The SBA determines eligibility for the program based on the size and type of business and its financial resources.

The deadline for economic injury applications is January 16, 2009.
